

# Spelling Poster Activity

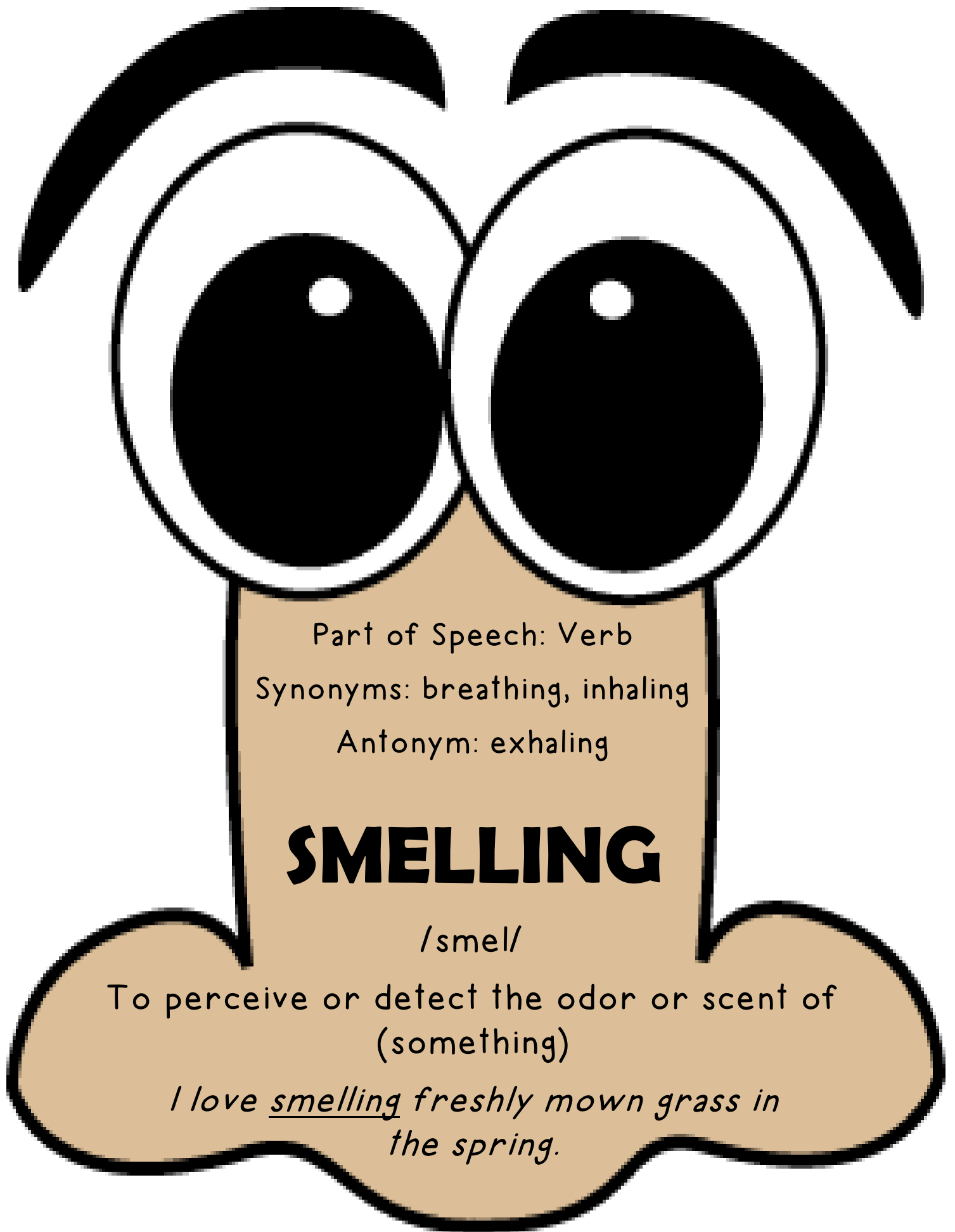
**Choose one of this week's list words as the basis for your spelling poster.**

2. Your spelling poster should include the following:
  - ☐ Spelling word written big & bold
  - ☐ Phonetic pronunciation of the word (Use a dictionary.)
  - ☐ Part of speech
  - ☐ Synonym and antonym (Use a thesaurus)
  - ☐ Definition (Use a dictionary!)
  - ☐ The spelling word used correctly in a sentence.
3. Additionally, your poster should be colorful and neat. Your teacher will provide construction paper. You may also purchase tag board for your poster.
